Jan. 2000
The Beginning
 In January 2000, Rudi Mellert takes the first step towards self-employment with his personal undertaking. As a professional metalworker, he establishes a mechanical workshop.

Feb. 2000
Production Starts
 With the investment in a 2-axis Mazak Quick Turn 3D lathe, R. Mellert begins producing turned parts in February.

Jun. 2000
Establishment of the Company M & H GmbH
 Already in June of the same year, he joins forces with Fritz Haberstroh. The company M & H GmbH is launched and, with one other employee, operates as a supplier for the construction of roller coasters.

Jul. 2000
New Machine
 With the purchase of an additional machine, quality and production capacity are significantly increased. The Mazak VTC-30-C is still rendering faithful service.

2001
First International Order
 With the first order from the USA, the refurbishment of roller coaster cars, the company enters the international market.

2001
Vehicle Frame Manufacturing
 M&H GmbH is contracted by Zierer GmbH & Co. KG to manufacture vehicle frames.

2001
First Christmas Party
 M&H GmbH gradually expands production and employs additional staff. At the end of the year, the company is able to hold its first company Christmas party with its four-man team.

2001
Complete Car Construction
 This year M&H GmbH fulfils its biggest order in the company's history – complete car construction for a Zierer GmbH & Co. KG roller coaster in Liseberg, Sweden.

2002
Lift for Water Ride
 Products from M&H GmbH can be found in other amusement and recreational parks. The company constructs a lift for the water ride in the Wiener Prater and the Roman Tower in the Familypark on Lake Neusiedl.

2003
Great Coaster USA Braking System
 The American company Great Coaster International Inc. commissions M&H GmbH with the construction of the braking systems for their roller coasters.

2006
"Maibaum" Mega-Project
 M&H GmbH proves its merit with two large-scale orders. For ABC Rides in Switzerland, the company produces the entire "Maibaum" project. With the completion of the observation tower in Steinwasen Park, it fulfils its second major order.

Tube Coaster Construction
 M&H GmbH gathers speed in the manufacturing of roller coasters. The company builds a complex tube coaster.


